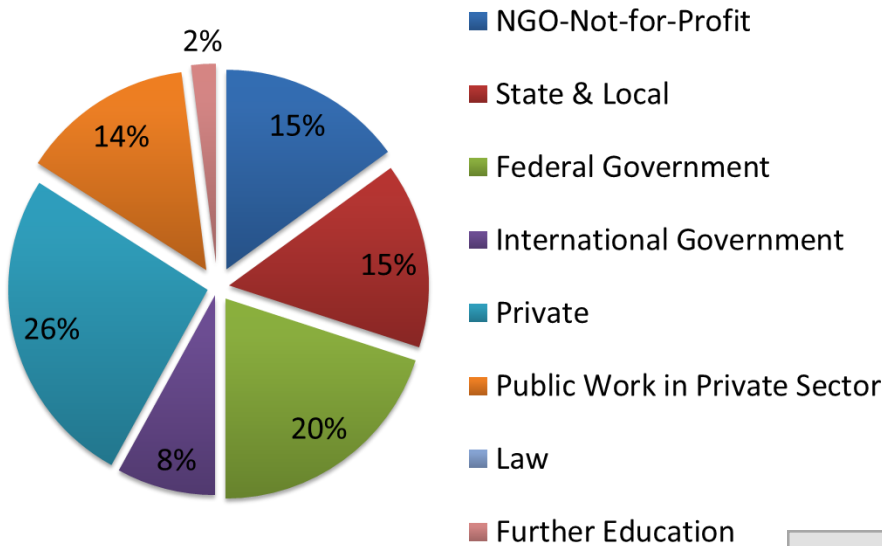


Employment by Sector

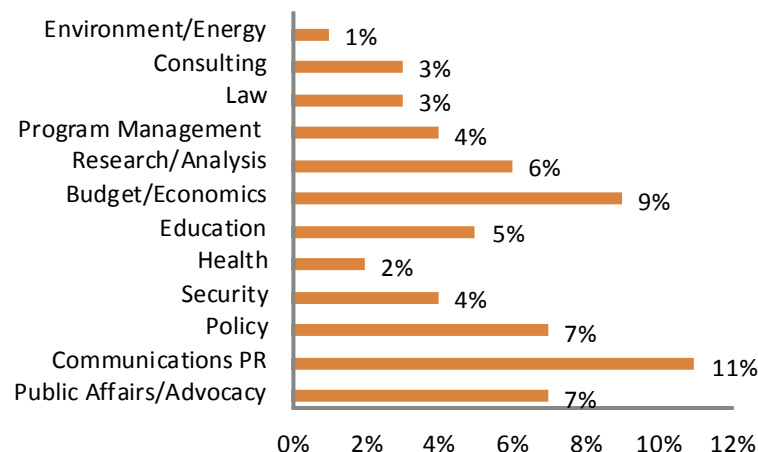
