Every month, **4-5 speakers** came to Maxwell to recruit, to give information sessions, and to hold career discussions with our students.

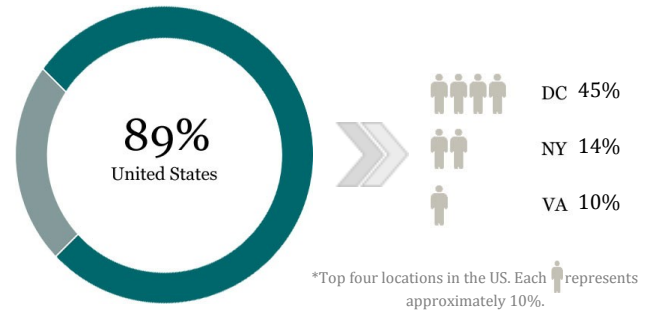

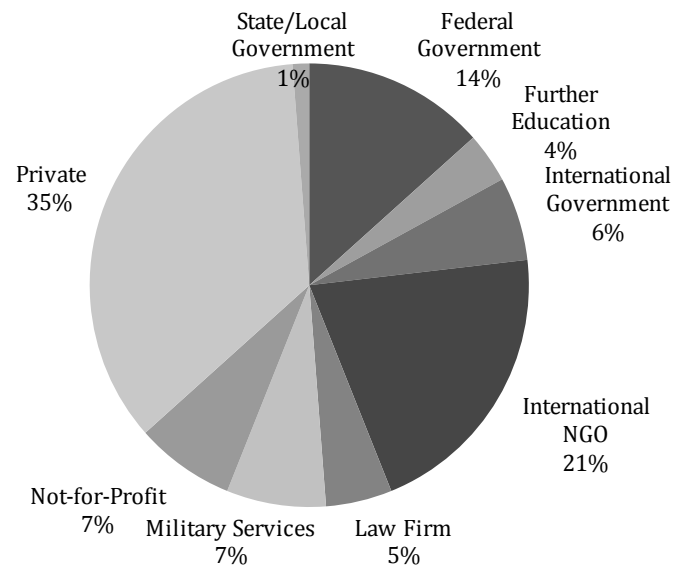
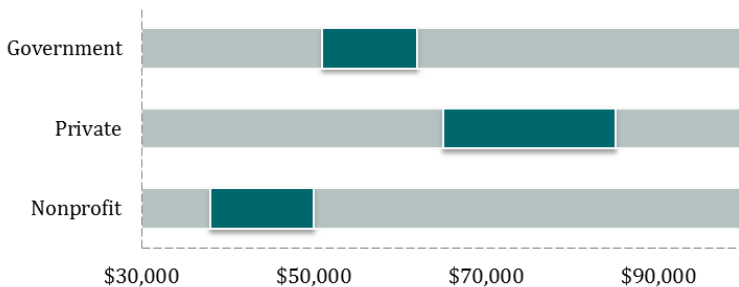
