

Political Science Minor Checklist

The minor in political science requires 18 credits of coursework. Students are required to take one course at the 100 level. Of the remaining 15 credits, 12 are taken in courses numbered 300 or above. The remaining 3 credits may be taken at any level.

PSC minors must take at least one course from the approved list of courses with international content. MAX 123 or MAX 132 courses do not count as part of the PSC minor.

PSC courses with a grade of D may not be applied toward the minor requirements effective Fall 2017 matriculation.

- 3 credits = one 100-level PSC course (AP course accepted)**
- 12 credits = four upper division PSC courses (300 or above)**
- 3 credits = any PSC course (lower or upper-division course)**

Graduation with a B.A. or a minor in political science requires a 2.0 average in the upper-division coursework applied toward the major or minor.
